Install the new pump in the opposite order you used to remove the old one. Reconnect the fuel lines, wiring connections, and vent tubes, and reinstall the fuel tank. Reconnect the fuel filler tube. Reconnect the negative battery cable.

Install the new fuel pump onto the tank and secure with the locking ring. Using a light spray lubricant on the seal will make it go back into the tank much easier. There is a tab on the pump that marries to the top of the tank so it can only go in one way. Replace the locking ring and turn it clockwise until it clicks back into position.

First, disconnect the clip on top of the fuel pump. Then, use a 10mm socket to remove the nuts that secure the fuel pump to the tank. Once all the nuts are off, pull the unit out from the tank and remove the pump from its bracket. Figure 9.
